

New \$10 Note Tracking Procedure



for the Cashmaster Note and Coin Scale

1. Turn on the cash counter.
2. Gather 100 x \$10 notes with a mix of 50% old notes and 50% new notes.
3. Randomly mix notes together.
4. Set machine to count \$10 in loose notes mode.
5. Place approx 10-12 x \$10 notes onto the scale.
6. After a reading is displayed, continue adding notes in batches of 10-12 notes until all 100 notes are on the note holder.
7. If the display reads “Too many notes. Remove some” at any time, remove a few notes until you get a valid reading then continue
8. Once completed, remove notes from hod.
9. Repeat process 4 and 5 but increase batch size to 20-25 notes at a time .
10. Please make sure that the cash counter can accept 20-25 notes at a time before any further counting is done.
11. If you are using bundle or flats and folds mode, and you keep receiving the message “Suspect”, you may need to count the notes in loose mode and add the rubber band once counted.
