New \$5 Notes Issue date: 1st September, 2016

On the 1st of September 2016 The Reserve Bank will be releasing the first of the new generation \$5 notes. All current denomination of notes will be replaced gradually with new generation notes.

THE NEW \$5 BANKNOTE

Thomas Findlay Group has been involved in this process from its inception and testing of the new \$5 notes has been carried out during that time. The results of that testing has shown that the new notes are within the + or – tolerances of our range of Cash Scales in use.

Therefore, an upgrade is not required for the following models:

- Sigma 170
- Sigma 105
- Sigma 165
- Sigma 100

However, whilst older models will not need an upgrade, there may be some issues during the changeover. These machines may be slower to adjust to the new notes, but the accuracy of the count will not be affected. Older models include:

- Omega CDC
- Omega CFC
- Omega C

Please Note: In the event that any of the remaining denominations to be issued i.e. 10, 20, 50 and 100 are outside our +/-tolerance levels, Sigma 170's, Sigma 105's, Sigma 165's and Sigma 100's can be upgraded to the new weights via SD card. This does not require a service call from Thomas Findlay as the upgrade can easily be done by staff on site. Models Omega C, CFC and CDC, due to their age (10 years+), cannot be upgraded.
